## THOR LIMITED WARRANTY

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All THOR AV audio products are warranted to the original purchaser to be free of defects in materials and workmanship for a period of one year from date of purchase. During this period, THOR AV will, at its discretion, repair the defective unit or replace it with a new or rebuilt.

The warranty does NOT cover:

- Damage due to abuse, misuse, shipping damage or accident.
- Damage due to operation contrary to the instructions in the product instruction manual.
- Units that have been serviced by unauthorized personnel.
- Microphone accessories. Cables are guaranteed for 30 days and repair or replacement shall be at THOR AV's discretion.

All implied warranties, including warranties on merchantability and fitness, are limited in time to the length of this warranty. Some states do not allow time limitations on implied warranties, so this limitation may not apply to you. THOR AV's liability is limited to the repair or replacement of its product. THOR AV shall in no way be held liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting from the use of their product or its software, including, without limitation, damages from loss of business profits, business interruption, loss of business information or other pecuniary loss. ### WARRANTY SERVICE

You will be responsible for shipping charges to THOR AV and the product will be returned by THOR AV. We reserve the right to inspect any product that may be the subject of any warranty claim before repair is carried out. To qualify for warranty service, documentation showing the date of purchase may be required. Final determination of warranty coverage lies solely with THOR AV.

### NON-WARRANTY SERVICE

If it is determined that the product does not meet the terms of our warranty, you will be billed for labor, materials, return shipping and insurance. There is a \$100 USD minimum charge for materials and labor. Appropriate shipping charges will be applied. We require payment in advance of repair by credit card; we accept Visa and Master Card. In the event the charges are over the minimum charge, THOR AV will contact you and inform you of the cost of the repair before any work is completed.




### OMNIDIRECTIONAL POLAR PATTERN





# THOR:

## BEST PRACTICES

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### BEST PRACTICES FOR USING HEADWORN MICROPHONES


- Dedicate each microphone to a single user for consistent audio mixing performance.
- Choose the appropriate microphone boom length for the user.
- Instruct the user on proper placement with minimal microphone boom adjustments.
- Store each microphone in low-humidity environments.

## PLACEMENT

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### MIC PLACEMENT

- Install the pop filter on the microphone boom. (Optional)
- Position the microphone and ear hook around the ear.
- Gently bend the boom to position the microphone capsule just below the corner of the mouth.
- To decrease pops and plosives, avoid placing the microphone directly in front of the mouth.



## HEADSET ADAPTER

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### ATTACHING THE HEADSET ADAPTER

- Insert the front of microphone ear hook (bottom) from the back and gently move forward.
- Place the headset adaptor around the back of the head, with the boom on the left side.




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## CABLING

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### REPLACING CABLE

- Grab the bottom of the ear hook and the cable connector.
- Firmly pull them straight out.
- To reconnect, align the arrows.
- Carefully and firmly insert connector into microphone ear hook.

## FAQS

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What type of mics are the Hammer SE9 and SE11

Omnidirectional single ear headworn mics with high gain before feedback.

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What is the difference between the Hammer SE9 and SE11

The only difference is the microphone boom length. The SE9 has a 90mm boom and is ideal for small to medium sized heads. The SE11 is for larger sized heads.

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What type of mic connectors are available

TA4F, 3.5mm, XLR3, Hirose4, and MIPRO. Be sure to check with your manufacturer for connector type.

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What colors are available

Black, Brown, & Tan

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Is the dual-ear headset adaptor included with the purchase

Yes

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What are some ways to optimize the performance of your mic

Adjust the gain accordingly on the microphone channel on your audio console. Position the mic capsule close to the user's face and directed just below the corner of the mouth to avoid plosives. Tweak the channel EQ as needed based on uniqueness of the room, how your audio system is EQ'd, and by using HPF and LPF. Dedicating one microphone for each user prolongs the performance life.
